


**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**BETWEEN**  
**FACULTY OF MEDICINE, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**  
**AND**  
**DOKKYO MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, JAPAN**


Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and Dokkyo Medical University, Japan, conclude this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of effective academic relation. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relation through academic collaboration between both institutions.

1. Both institutions agree to promote and develop this academic collaboration by the following means:
  - a. Exchange of staff member, undergraduate and graduate students
  - b. Staff development
  - c. Visiting professorship
  - d. Execution of joint research projects
  - e. Provision of lectures and seminars
  - f. Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
  - g. Other mutually beneficial projects which may be defined from time to time
2. Details of the implementation of many particular exchange resulting from the agreement shall be consulted with each other and develop specific plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned above. The details of exchange of staff members and academic information are placed in addendum.
3. This agreement may be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It may also be terminated with in that period by either institution by giving the other institution not less than six-months of its intention to terminate it.
4. This agreement will be effective from the date of signing for a period of three years. The agreement will be extended beyond that period after discussion by representative of both institutions. The discussion can begin anytime before the final six months of the initial period of the agreement
